

# NBC Winter Storage Agreement

## WINTER STORAGE 2017-2018 – DRY SAILORS, KEEL BOATS, SUNFISH RACKS

Winter storage space is now available for the off-season. If a member had a space last year, has no unresolved violations for prior year agreement, and payment is received by September 30th they will automatically secure a space for this winter. If you were a non-user last winter and you pay by September 30th, space will be assigned based on Club seniority. If you request space, but pay after September 30th, space will be assigned based upon order or receipt of payment. In the event that your boat cannot be accommodated your funds will be promptly returned.

A MAXIMUM BOAT LENGTH OF 30 FEET IS ALLOWED FOR STORAGE AT THE CLUB. MAXIMUM WEIGHT IS 10,000 POUNDS.

Please fill in the following form, complete and sign the Winter Storage Agreement on the reverse side, and return the completed form and signed agreement with your payment, postmarked by September 30, 2017. No boat will be hauled or stored without a completed and signed Winter Storage Agreement.

**WINTER STORAGE AGREEMENT: 2017-2018**

Nyack Boat Club, Inc. agrees to:

1. Provide space, when available, on Club property for storage of the herein designated member's boat. Placement of the boat in the storage yard is at the discretion of the haul-out chairman.

2. Provide adequate equipment to safely haul and move the boat within the storage yard. Boats may not exceed 10,000 lbs. in weight or 30 feet in length to qualify for storage.

Nyack Boat Club assumes no liability or responsibility for any privately owned vessel and will not be held liable for fire, theft, or damage to the owner's vessel, its equipment, appurtenances, furnishings, or property.

The member agrees to:

1. Be prepared to haul and launch his boat on the scheduled date unless relief is given through a written appeal as provided in the House and Grounds Rules.

2. Pay a charge of \$50.00 if his boat is not ready to launch as scheduled or delayed without following the procedure in item #1. In addition, winter storage rights will be terminated.

3. Abide by Club rules pertaining to launch and haul-out.

4. Maintain full insurance coverage on his vessel at all times during the term of this agreement including "all risk" hull coverage and liability coverage.

5. Provide a safe and stable cradle to hold the boat.

6. Label the cradle with the member's name.

7. Member understands that the Nyack Boat Club is committed to compliance with State and Federal Law prohibiting discharges that cause a substantial visible contrast in color or cloudiness, or cause visible oil sheen on the waters of the Hudson River. Member agrees to ensure that in washing, sanding, decommissioning, commissioning, and cleaning their boat they will comply with these standards and with the Club pollution prevention procedures.

8. Members are to remove from Club property all hazardous substances such as waste oil, antifreeze, gasoline, diesel fuel, antifouling paints, and residues, and dispose of them in an environmentally responsible manner.

9. Member agrees to use a dustless sander with an appropriate shop-vac for sanding, and that material generated will be properly bagged and disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner, away from Club Property.

10. Boat Washing - All boats that have been bottom-painted must capture all water used in washing. This water goes into the sewer system where Orangetown processes it. When in operation, the Club's new wash-water collection system collects all water used in boat washing and ultimately directs the flow to the sewer plant in Orangetown. *If this system is not in operation, or if you are not sure if it is in operation, you must collect your wash water.* Strict adherence to these instructions is imperative to conform to DEC requirements.

11. Clean up all residues and debris resulting from boat maintenance work and winter storage, and dispose of same as directed.

I, the undersigned, agree to the terms and conditions of the Winter Storage Agreement with the understanding that a violation of these terms may cause the loss of my storage privileges at the Nyack Boat Club. I further understand that my boat will not be hauled without the execution of this agreement and the payment of any fees or dues for the use of this facility.
